1. Policy. 2. Publication. The district shall public notification of this policy by several methods. In addition, the district shall include a statement of nondiscriminatory policy in any bulletins, announcements, publications, catalogs, application forms, or other recruitment materials that are made available to participants, students, applicants, or employees. The publication requirements may be met either by including appropriate inserts in existing materials and publications or by revising and reprinting the materials and publications.

3. Review Schedule. This policy shall be reviewed in accordance with the Policy Review Schedule published by the Superintendent.
