

TITLE: Extra-Curricular Activities and Assignments
State Board of Education Ref: 18A-4-16; 18-2-25

All extra-curricular assignments must be recommended by the county superintendent of schools, and subject to the approval of the county board of education, if county supplements are to be paid.

Extra-curricular duties shall mean, but not be limited to, any activities that occur at times other than regularly scheduled working hours, which include the instructing, coaching, chaperoning, escorting, providing support services, or caring for the needs of students, and which occur on a regularly scheduled basis (18-A-4-15).

Extra-curricular assignments shall be in accordance with applicable personnel policies of the county board of education and by mutual agreement of the employee and the superintendent, or a designated employee, subject to board approval.

Extra-curricular assignment contracts shall contain the terms and conditions of employment and shall indicate the maximum number of hours required for each assignment. The maximum number of hours are to be determined by mutual agreement between the employee and the superintendent, or a designated representative, subject to board approval.

Special conditions applicable to coaches, assistant coaches, and band directors are prescribed in 18-A-4-15, and shall become part of their extra-curricular contract.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES POLICY

The Gilmer County Board of Education shall exercise the control, supervision and regulation of all extra-curricular activities of the students in the schools in the county. All extra-curricular activities are available on a nondiscriminatory basis in compliance with Title IX of the Educational Amendments of 1972.
